Oxford German Olympiad 2019: New Books in German Translation Prize

**Note that the closing date for submissions is 12 noon, Friday, 15
March 2019**

In partnership with the Oxford German Network, *New Books in German*, a twice-yearly journal publishing news of German literary translation, is holding a translation competition for UK undergraduates.

There will be one prize. The competition is open to undergraduates of German studying at a British or Irish university.

Each submission should consist of two parts:

1. Produce a translation into English of Chapter One of Vincenzo Todisco's *Das Eidechsenkind* (please see online competition page for PDF extract).
2. Write a commentary explaining points of interest and indicating any particular translation difficulties you encountered (up to 350 words).

The competition will be judged by members of *New Books in German*. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

PRIZE

The winner will be awarded a cash (cheque) prize of £100 and invited to a prize-giving ceremony at the Weston Library, University of Oxford, in June 2019. The winning translation will also feature on the *New Books in German* website.

- Please note that we cannot accept postal entries. Entries received after the deadline at 12 noon, Friday, 15th March 2019 will not be considered.
