Oxford German Olympiad 2019: New Books in German Translation Prize

Note that the closing date for submissions is 12 noon, Friday, 15 March 2019

In partnership with the Oxford German Network, New Books in German, a twice-yearly journal publishing news of German literary translation, is holding a translation competition for UK undergraduates.

There will be one prize. The competition is open to undergraduates of German studying at a British or Irish university.

Each submission should consist of two parts:

1. Produce a translation into English of Chapter One of Vincenzo Todisco's *Das Eidechsenkind* (please see online competition page for PDF extract).

2. Write a commentary explaining points of interest and indicating any particular translation difficulties you encountered (up to 350 words).

The competition will be judged by members of New Books in German. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

PRIZE

The winner will be awarded a cash (cheque) prize of £100 and invited to a prize-giving ceremony at the Weston Library, University of Oxford, in June 2019. The winning translation will also feature on the New Books in German website.

- Please note that we cannot accept postal entries. Entries received after the deadline at 12 noon, Friday, 15th March 2019 will not be considered.
